4 **155-18.20 DEFINITIONS.**

5 ADULT-USE CANNABIS CULTIVATION CENTER. A facility operated by an organization or business that is
 6 cultivate, process, transport and perform other necessary activities to provide cannabis and cannabis-
 7 infused products to cannabis business establishments.

8 ADULT-USE CANNABIS DISPENSING ORGANIZATION or DISPENSARY. A facility operated by an
 9 organization or business that is registered by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to
 10 acquire medical cannabis from a registered cultivation center for the purpose of dispensing cannabis,
 11 paraphernalia, or related supplies and educational materials to registered qualifying patients in
 12 accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

13 ADULT-USE CANNABIS CRAFT GROWER. A facility operated by an organization or business that is
 14 licensed by the Department of Agriculture to cultivate, dry, cure, and package cannabis and perform
 15 other necessary activities to make cannabis available for sale at a dispensing organization or use at a
 16 processing organization. A craft grower may contain up to 5,000 square feet of canopy space on its
 17 premises for plants in the flowering state. The Department of Agriculture may authorize an increase or
 18 decrease of flowering stage cultivation space in increments of 3,000 square feet by rule based on market
 19 need, craft grower capacity, and the licensee's history of compliance or noncompliance, with a
 20 maximum space of 14,000 square feet for cultivating plants in the flowering stage, which must be
 21 cultivated in all stages of growth in an enclosed and secure area. A craft grower may share premises
 22 with a processing organization or a dispensing organization, or both, provided each licensee stores
 23 currency and cannabis or cannabis-infused products in a separate secured vault to which the other

24 licensee does not have access or all licensees sharing a vault share more than 50% of the same
25 ownership.

26 ADULT-USE CANNABIS INFUSER ORGANIZATION or INFUSER. A facility operated by an organization or
27 business that is licensed by the Department of Agriculture to directly incorporate cannabis or cannabis
28 concentrate into a product formulation to produce a cannabis-infused product.

29 ADULT-USE PROCESSING ORGANIZATION or PROCESSOR. A facility operated by an organization or
30 business that is licensed by the Department of Agriculture to either extract constituent chemicals or
31 compounds to produce cannabis concentrate or incorporate cannabis or cannabis concentrate into a
32 product formulation to produce a cannabis product.
